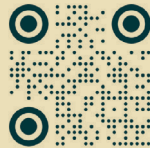
WELCOME TO RUSH CREEK LODGE & SPA AT YOSEMITE!

Get the day started right with our full-service breakfast and a cup of freshly brewed custom coffee from our Restaurant.

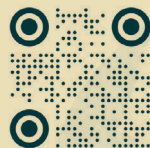
If you're in more of a rush, pop into the General Store for lattes, freshly made breakfast items and trail supplies.

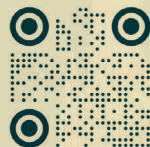


DINNER

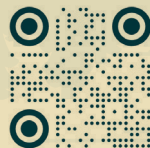

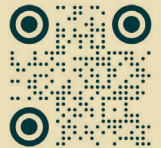
Our online store offers favorites like our signature bath and body products, souvenir wooden stickers, reusable water bottles, apparel, gift cards and more.

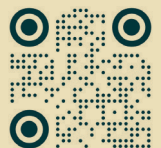
